 - The incorporated element, *-ŋmā*, is suspected to not have an independent form. There are words that, when incorporated, take this shape, like *ŋmol*, but that word is not suspected to be related to the incorporated element here.
- *Mī-* /~b̥i/ [mɛ] v. 1. To dig
 - *Mī-...-ŋā* /~b̥i-...-g̬a/ [mɛ-...-ŋa] v. 1. To plant seeds
- *Mī-...-kā* /~b̥i-...-ka/ [mɛ-...-kə] v. 1. To make 2. To construct 3. To establish
 - the stem $\sqrt{mī}$, in this context, may or may not be connected to $\sqrt{mī}$ 'to bury'. Some *ŋmolō* scholars say that it is not related to $\sqrt{mī}$ 'to bury' and that it is wholly unique. They posit this by saying it could just as easily be **b̥i-* and the incorporated element *-kā* 'incr. hand' causes nasal prosody yielding **b̥i- → mī-*
- *Akai* /akai/ [ʔaxai] *Qo* [!ɔ:] *Qoqō* [!ɔ!ŋɔ:] intr. 1. Hey! Howdy! Ahoy!
 - This word seems to be an onomatopoeic break of normal phonetic constraints, being the only word to begin with a vowel, phonemically, and being the only word recorded with [?]. The other form, *Qo*, is the only word with a click.
